Occupational Exposures

All NPPs have radiation safety programme and work procedures intended to control the occupational exposures. As per AERB directive, the cumulative effective dose limit for individual radiation workers is one hundred millisievert (100mSv) for consecutive block of five years and the annual effective dose to individual workers in any calender year shall not exceed the limit of 30 millisievert (30 mSv). The information on occupational exposures of workers in operating NPPs is brought out in the Annual Reports of AERB, which are available on the website.
